STEAM ACTIVITIES FOR YOUTH

STEAM Skill Builds (After school, year-round)

After-school Skill Builds are 90-minute classes (one day a week, for five weeks) where youth aged 6-13 learn about a particular STEAM area of focus.

STEAM Discovery Days (Saturday Drop-ins, year-round)

Flexible Saturday sessions where youth aged 6-13 explore different steam activities each week from 10 am to 2 pm. Parents can drop off or stay and play (dependent upon the volume of attendees).

STEAM Creator Camps - (Summer & Winter)

Build knowledge, friendships and a HECK of a lot more at five-day STEAM education camps designed to create mad scientists and crazy creators (before & after care available).

All held at Pinnguaq's Lindsay Makerspace at 87 Adelaide St. North.
